What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	<b>\$1,000</b> person/ <b>\$2,000</b> family per calendar year.	Generally, you must pay all the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. Well-child care, <u>prescription drugs</u> , in- <u>network preventive care</u> , in- <u>network</u> <u>urgent care</u> , in- <u>network</u> colonoscopies/ sigmoidoscopies, breast pumps, office services and independent labs for mental health/substance abuse services and services subject to <u>copayments</u> .
